	Enter Proton Hall extension, point out testing and assembly areas
	Walk Down to the e-hall (first tour stop)
	Walk back from the e-hall to the Driver Control Room
	Take stairs up to the I2 terminal (second tour stop)
	Visit the roof of the 520 MeV cyclotron
	Walk down staircase into Meson Hall
	Proceed into the Meson Hall loading bay area, show UCN
	Walk past the helium recovery facility to the TR-13, look down to CMMS
	Exit Meson Hall via RCA side door and walk towards ISAC-I
	Enter ISAC-I Experimental Hall via main entrance and walk to OLIS (3rd tour stop)
	Walk up to the gallery and go to the TITAN (4th tour stop)
	Cross to ISAC-II building, pass by the RIB control room and walk down the stairs on the north side and show the SRF area
	Walk to the ARIEL building and enter CANREB area on ground floor (5th tour stop)
	Walk back to MOB and leave the site through Badge Room
5:30 pm	Arrive back in the Auditorium

Other information:

- 1. TRIUMF is easily <u>accessible by transit</u> and <u>car</u>; our parking lot is open for parking but metered.
